Hermleigh's Cardinal Field was completed in the spring of 2012 and is one of only a few turf high school baseball fields in the state of Texas that boasts a complete turf playing surface in both the infield and outfield as well.

The installation of the TruHop turf from Shaw Industries is the first in the world. It provides a quicker playing surface which resembles that of natural grass, unlike other turf fields. Cardinal Field dimensions are 310' down the lines and 340' to center. The field faces the southeast with a predominantly southwest wind blowing.

Along with an outstanding playing surface, the field features large, covered dugouts, a metal outfield fence including a 10' high raised area in centerfield for the batter's eye and spectacular lighting. Seating at the field is divided into three sections, two of which are covered, and have a total capacity of 175. An elevated pressbox, including a filming platform, a 20 ft LED scoreboard and a covered picnic area between fields rounds out the features of one of the nicest baseball facilities in the state.

In-game entertainment includes a public address announcer, along with music during pre-game and between innings. Newly built restrooms are located at the concession stand in the north endzone of the adjacent football field.

Pricing for use of the baseball facility is \$300 for a single game, which includes use of the facility and gameday staff. The cost for a doubleheader is \$500 and also includes facility usage and staff fees. Responsibility for securing and paying of game officials rests with the two opposing schools.
